Valuable information regarding the joint lunch at Public School of Ballet in Berlin and the School of Artistry

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS	OUR ANSWERS
Is a warm meal served on all days of school, including Saturdays?	Yes , every student can have a warm meal on school days between Monday and Saturday .
How is the participation in supply organized?	Fundamentally there are two options for joining lunch: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- either cashless on the base of a contract of supply- or for cash without a contract of supply For students in grades 5 and 6, no contract is required, as their participation in the communal lunch is free of charge for all-day schools due to statutory regulations of the state of Berlin.
How is the lunch supply organized during holidays?	Balanced with the school's servicing concept a joint lunch during school holidays won't be offered. Exceptions can be individual agreements for boarding school-students or training periods which have been coordinated with the school administration.
At what time can a contract of supply be signed?	Parents who wish to sign a contract of supply (cashless with one warm main meal) for their child can do so at any time , also during the current school year. What are the advantages of the completion of contract?	Students with a contract of supply receive their lunch cashless and at discounted rates . Currently the benefit comes to 0,30 € per portion.
How is the supply organized on a Saturday?	Saturdays are school days. Therefore the students can participate in the joint lunch at the prevailing terms on these days, too.

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<p>In case we sign a contract of supply: How do the employees at the serving counter make sure that we've already paid for our child?</p>	<p>All students with a contract of supply receive daily-based vouchers for the entire current month at the beginning of each month at the cafeteria. The vouchers include the date and the contract number. Food stamps are also available to all students who attend lunch free of charge (5th / 6th grade pupils, BuT station * s)</p> <p>Fundamentally the students receive their “meals by contract” only when showing the appropriate voucher.</p> <p>In case the student has forgotten or lost her/his voucher there are special arrangements which are put up in the cafeteria.</p>
<p>My child receives benefits from the educational- and participation package (BuT). How much do I have to pay for the daily lunch?</p>	<p>Pupils who receive earmarked benefits for school meals from the BuT are free of charge. The prerequisite for this is the submission of a valid certificate from the responsible authorities (e.g. Berlin Pass or statement on the assumption of costs by the city administration, county or job center).</p>
<p>Which system of catering do you use? Do you prepare your food fresh every day or are the meals delivered by a central kitchen?</p>	<p>We prepare our meals freshly. Every day and on-the-spot. No matter if breakfast, lunch or dinner. Our modern equipment includes a heater, dumper, combined steamer, an oven etc. With this our crew is able to deliver only the best quality of food to you, prepared the way you like it.</p>
<p>Is my child able to inform her-/himself about the lunch offer in advance?</p>	<p>Of course. Everyone can take a look at the menu early enough. There are three options:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The menu is available on your website www.breha-gmbh.de. 2. Menus for take away are available in the cafeteria. 3. The menu is put up and well visible at several places in the cafeteria and inside school on the way to the cafeteria.
<p>Is there an advance booking-system?</p>	<p>From our experience, neither students nor teachers are in favour of obligatory advanced bookings.</p> <p>For this reason, with us the students eat a la carte. This means that every guest decides right at the service counter what to eat and „what does her/him good“. For lunch students can choose between two warm main meals (one is vegetarian) as well as compatible components every day.</p>
<p>Are all lunch offers available till closing time?</p>	<p>We try hard to offer a wide range of food during the entire opening time. Nevertheless, we cannot guarantee that both meals are available till the very end.</p> <p>Those students who want to pick a specific lunch are able to hand in a personal wish at the food bank one day in advance. For this you find menus for pre-bookers to tick off in the cafeteria. These are also available for download on www.breha-gmbh.de.</p>

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<p>My child suffers from food intolerance. How do you organize the supply of students with nutritional restrictions due to a certain allergy?</p>	<p>Students who suffer from food intolerance due to an allergy need to present a medical certificate (specialist!) after being accepted by the school. Then, we usually discuss the individual supply (internal or external) as well as the higher costs which are connected with that with the parents.</p> <p>Because we prepare our meals freshly and thanks to our large kitchen team we have so far been able to react on special nutritional requirements (<u>medically certified!</u>) in most cases. For this we offer especially-bought food and especially-prepared single components on a sufficient scale. As an individual orientation for the students when choosing their meal we mention the most common notifiable allergens on our menus and price lists.</p> <p><u>Notice:</u> We don't incur liability for the individual eating patterns of our guests and possible resulting health consequences. At bottom our offer is based on the principle of a free choice of components. Because we cannot supervise this we are not able to take responsibility for the correct diet of every student.</p>
<p>Is it possible for my child to have breakfast or (on long training days) even dinner in the cafeteria?</p>	<p>Yes, both is possible! Beside the offers around the lunch every guest of the cafeteria can cater for her-/himself the whole day following her/his individual needs. Here she/he can choose between a wide range of warm and cold snacks, sandwiches, dairy products, fruits, vegetables as well as warm and cold drinks. Price lists for this are put up in the cafeteria.</p>
<p>What are the opening hours of the cafeteria?</p>	<p>Monday to Friday: 07.00 am – 03.30 pm and 06.00 pm – 07:30 pm Saturday: 07.00 am – 02.30 pm</p> <p>For boarding school-students extended opening hours apply on weekends.</p>
<p>Is it also possible to talk to you directly about any issues concerning the supply?</p>	<p>Of course. You can reach us by phone every day. In case we aren't available please leave your name and your number on our mailbox so we can call you back. By previous arrangement (by phone or e-mail) we also hold a "kitchen-surgery" on-site in the cafeteria.</p>
